Full Day Camps K-6

Provide your K-6 camper a memorable summer experience at Kids' Campus! Organized into houses, each campus provides language, art, and dance/fitness with three additional offerings. Join friends from 9 am to 4 pm each day for six fun-filled hour-long units, lunch, and two supervised break sessions. Kids' Campus runs for five days with an extended fifteen day program offered at Omega House. Well-trained staffers engage your child through their daily campus activities.

Participants bring their enthusiasm, love of learning, and a bagged lunch; snack is provided. Tuition for five-day camp is \$379 and fifteen-day Omega House is \$1,129. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Kids' Campus?

A: Kids' Campus is a full-day activities-based summer enrichment camp for elementary school-aged children. Campers interact with six topic activities daily, which vary depending on the location or campus "house."

Q: What activities are offered?

A: Activities will vary at each location (house) and could include the following: foreign language and culture, art, dance, fitness, cultural cooking, origami, martial arts, robotics, theatre, stage combat, hip hop, and/or video production.

Q: What grade level should I choose for my child?

A: Select the grade level the child is in during the 2008-09 school year.

Q: Will snacks be provided? A: Yes. One snack is provided daily.

Q: How is the day at Kids' Campus structured? A: Kids' Campus starts at 9 am and ends at 4 pm.

The children meet with all six activity instructors for approximately 55 minutes daily. Two breaks are provided, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. One snack is provided. Lunch is scheduled from 12:15 to 12:45. Children bring a bagged lunch.

Q: How large are the classes?

A: Camp sizes are limited to 8 to 15 children. Small camp size helps provide more personal instruction and individual attention.

Q: Who will be leading the activities?

A: All Kids' Campus instructors have been processed through Fairfax County Public Schools Department of Human Resources with a background check and fingerprinting. Instructors have experience working with children and within their activity field.

Q: Is transportation provided? A: No. Parents provide transportation.

Q: My child does not attend a FCPS school. Can he/she still attend Kids' Campus?

A: Yes. Kids' Campus welcomes both FCPS and non-FCPS students. However, non-FCPS students must submit additional documentation along with their completed registration form and payment.

Q: Are there any scholarships offered for Kids' Campus?

A: Unfortunately, at this time, no scholarships or discounts are provided.

Q: Is there a registration deadline?

A: Campers must register 2 weeks before the start date of the individual camp.
